



FSPMR Poster Preparation and Submission Guidelines

Poster Presentation Instructions

We appreciate your contribution to the FSPMR scientific program. Abstracts not accepted will have the opportunity to display their abstract as a Poster during scheduled viewing periods throughout the meeting.

Poster Display Specifications –

Location: Posters will be displayed inside/outside the Exhibit Hall to be easily accessible during all scheduled breaks throughout the meeting. The Final Program will highlight poster topics and location to encourage attendees to view them. Authors should be available near their posters to discuss their research during Exhibit Hall hours.

Size and Display Criteria: The FSPMR will have your Poster printed on a cork board and provide an easel to display it. **Posters must be received by FSPMR in PDF format no later than June 15, 2026. The posters should be 48 x 36 inches for proper display.**

Dismantling: If you want to keep your Poster, you may remove it after the Exhibit Hall closes on Saturday afternoon, or you may collect it from the FSPMR Registration Desk prior to the end of the conference.

Awards: Posters are scored by seasoned FSPMR physician members. Awards are presented for the 2 highest scoring posters at the conclusion of the meeting.

Value of Poster Presentations: A poster presentation is an excellent way to provide continuing education. The compact format offers a step-by-step explanation of procedures and results of scientific research or multiple case studies. The public display of the presentation allows viewers to examine the information at their own pace. An added benefit is the one-on-one contact between the presenter and viewer that can take place during poster presentation time. Poster presentations are best suited for a pilot study, a unique

idea, or a new procedure where all information can be displayed on a tackboard. Only text, graphs, photographs, and artwork are placed on the board.

FDA Status and Commercialism:

If a device or drug requiring FDA approval is covered by the material used in the poster, the poster must include the FDA clearance status of the medical devices and pharmaceuticals for the uses discussed or described. “Off label” uses of a device or pharmaceutical may be described so long as the lack of FDA clearance for such uses is also disclosed. Funding of poster exhibits is limited to individuals, educational facilities and hospitals. Commercial funding is not allowed.

- Printed posters & Easels will be provided by FSPMR at the Annual Meeting
