Abstract Submission Guidelines

Call for Abstracts – FSPMR Annual Scientific Meeting

Meeting Date: October 9-10, 2026

Location: The Wave Hotel Lake Nona, Orlando Florida

Thank you for your interest in contributing to the scientific program of the FSPMR Annual Meeting. Abstract submissions should reflect original scholarship relevant to physical medicine, rehabilitation, pain management, or related disciplines.

Originality and Copyright

- Abstracts that have been previously presented or published must be **substantially revised**, including updated data or new analyses, in order to be considered.
- By submitting an abstract, authors grant FSPMR permission to reproduce and distribute the abstract in print and digital formats associated with the meeting.
- Ownership of the abstract remains with the author(s). Any third-party requests for use following the meeting will be referred back to the corresponding author.
- If an abstract is accepted, the presenting author is expected to share **original work** at the meeting. FSPMR reserves the right to remove abstracts that are published or presented elsewhere prior to the meeting date.

Abstract Format and Length

- Submissions must not exceed **300 words**.
- Documents must be submitted in **.DOCX format**, PDF not allowed.
- Figures, tables, and images are **not permitted**.
- The abstract text should be written as **one continuous paragraph**. Please do not include section headers such as "Background," "Methods," or "Results."
- References should be used sparingly. If included, list them at the end of the abstract using this format: *Author, Journal or Source, Year*.
- Any financial or industry support related to the research or poster development must be clearly disclosed at the end of the abstract.

Submission Policies and Deadlines

- Abstracts must be submitted no later than **May 10, 2026**.
- Once the submission deadline has passed, **no edits or revisions** will be permitted.

Review Process and Notification

- Submitting authors will be informed of acceptance decisions no later than May 30, 2026.
- All accepted submissions will be presented oral

Presenter Obligations

- At least one author must commit to attending the meeting serving as presenter.
- The presenter must be listed as either the first author or a co-author on the abstract.
- Registration fees are waived for presenters. FSPMR will provide 1 hotel room night (Friday) per Program.
